Did You Know?

Your gifts to the United Church Mission & Service support many local and regional missions and programs.

Every year, approximately 75% of donations to the United Church's Mission & Service funds are distributed among organizations and missions across Canada to support local community and justice work, theological education and faith formation, and local ministries, as well as the National Indigenous Church.

For 2022, **EOORC will receive \$135,520 from Mission & Service for Mission Support grants**, which will support:
