But there will be no gloom for those who were in anguish. In the former time he brought into contempt the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, but in the latter time he will make glorious the way of the sea, the land beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the nations. The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who lived in a land of deep darkness— on them light has shined. You have multiplied the nation, you have increased its joy; they rejoice before you as with joy at the harvest, as people exult when dividing plunder. For the yoke of their burden, and the bar across their shoulders, the rod of their oppressor, you have broken as on the day of Midian.

# Matthew 4:12-23 (NRSV)

Now when Jesus heard that John had been arrested, he withdrew to Galilee. He left Nazareth and made his home in Capernaum by the sea, in the territory of Zebulun and Naphtali, so that what had been spoken through the prophet Isaiah might be fulfilled: "Land of Zebulun, land of Naphtali, on the road by the sea, across the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles— the people who sat in darkness have seen a great light, and for those who sat in the region and shadow of death light has dawned." From that time Jesus began to proclaim, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near."

As he walked by the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon, who is

called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea—for they were fishermen. And he said to them, "Follow me, and I will make you fish for people." Immediately they left their nets and followed him. As he went from there, he saw two other brothers, James son of Zebedee and his brother John, in the boat with their father Zebedee, mending their nets, and he called them. Immediately they left the boat and their father and followed him.

Jesus went throughout Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and curing every disease and every sickness among the people.

Here at Grace, we will be hosting "MELT METHOD" classes, Thursdays 1 – 3 pm, beginning February 9<sup>th</sup> with instructor Gloria Laux.

# And Conversational French classes on Fridays 10-12, beginning February 10<sup>th</sup>, with Nicole Tyo. (Both are 8 week programs)

**MELT** helps to address a host of middle-age complaints: chronic pain, aching joints, weight gain, stress, wrinkles, digestive problems, low energy and insomnia. Researchers describe connective tissue as a three-dimensional, fluid-filled support network that surrounds the muscles, bones, nerves and organs. As we age, our bodies endure wear and tear that is thought to result in dehydration of this system. Even in young people, repetitive motions like running can compress and dry out the fascia. Once you learn the method, just 10 minutes three times a week is all you need. Gloria Laux started in dance classes at three years old and loved moving. Still does. While becoming an Aromatherapist in 1997 she learned about Pilates which lead her to other modalities. A friend suggested she check out the Melt Method and she was hooked, becoming the first instructor in Ontario.

**Conversational French course** will be offered by a retired qualified French language teacher, Nicole Tyo, who has several years of experience teaching all ages from junior kindergarten to post secondary students. Come learn some commonly used words and sentences to better communicate in French through activities , role playing and of course, lots of laughs.
